

BAPTISM.

Baptism is an outer sign of an inner transformation. It's the first thing Jesus calls His followers to do after they make a decision to follow Him, and a way that we publicly declare our new life in Christ.

When you're baptized, you will be lowered under water to represent your sinful nature dying with Christ. Then, you'll be lifted out of the water to symbolize your new life with Christ. When you walk into the water, you are letting the world know that you have stepped into a new life of faith in Jesus Christ and that you are committing to follow Him down a new path.

Whether you just started a relationship with Jesus or you've been following him for years, don't delay getting baptized.

Community Groups

Jesus Christ


